

# 2, 4, 8

## PURPOSE

**Practice 2, 4, 8 multiplication**

## MATERIALS

- **Deck of cards per pair (Use just 2s,4s and 8s)**
- **Dice**
- **Paper and pen**

## HOW TO PLAY

1. Take out the 2's, 4's and 8's in the pack to use.
2. Write the scoring system on the board.
3. Place these cards face down on table between players
4. Throw the dice e.g. 4
5. Pick up top card
6. Work out the multiplication sum and write it on score card e.g.  $4 \times 4 = 16$
7. Place card to one side. Next player takes a turn. Continue until all cards have been used.
8. After all the cards are used (6 turns each)
9. Look at each sum's answer and work out the score using the table below.
10. FOR EXAMPLE:  $6 \times 8 = 48$  will score 1 point as it falls between 31 and 79
11. Write the score next to each sum on the score card. The player with the biggest score wins.

## SCORING

IF THE ANSWER IS LESS THAN 30:  
**SCORE 2 POINTS**

IF THE ANSWER IS BETWEEN 31 AND 79:  
**SCORE 1 POINT**

IF THE ANSWER IS MORE THAN 80:  
**SCORE 3 POINTS**
